Section SAC Outreach Volunteer for China

Objective

Since there is a huge gap in the communication of the R10 members with students in China, (due to limited internet connection and restrictions on some essential platforms like Facebook, WhatsApp and google) a special set of outreach volunteers will be appointed for the following sections: Beijing, Chengdu, Guangzhou, Nanjing, Shanghai, Wuhan, Xian and Harbin. These volunteers will be coordinated by the R10 SAC outreach Coordinator. This team will be responsible for increasing awareness on R10 student activities in Chinese sections and conduct their own publicity campaign with the materials provided by the R10 SAC. This will not be a part of R10 SAC.

Budget: None

Tasks

- Appoint SAC outreach volunteers for China sections.
- Train the outreach volunteers by giving them clear tasks
- ▶ Check the progress of each volunteer quarterly and decide on the continuation of the member
- Give electronic certificates to retained volunteers at the end of the year

- Engagement of Chinese students as volunteers with R10 activities
- The tasks performed by each committee members at the end of each quarter

The initiative is created to persuade sections to organize activities between Student Branches, student members and branch counselors giving training on leadership, successful execution of student branch program and to run membership drives aiming to enhance student membership number and its retention
