- RESPONSE TO COVID - 19 (“BreathOfHope”) - The Breath of Hope team began developing a low-cost ventilator design to address the dire shortage of the machines in developing countries such as India, but the initiative soon expanded to address other problems faced by doctors and healthcare professionals. These include the lack of medical equipment such as oxygenation devices, personal protective equipment, intubation boxes, and safe ways to collect samples.
 - **HopeFlow** : HAC funded project. A low cost ventilator.
 - **HoodOfHope** : SCTIMST funded. Limited commercial production.
 - **ShieldOfHope** : 15000 units manufactured and are flexible compared to other brands.
 - **SafeCollect** : To collect the samples. Limited Deployments.
 - **Closed Space Air Filter** : to reduce aerosols.

 - **Respirator** : The breath support system.
