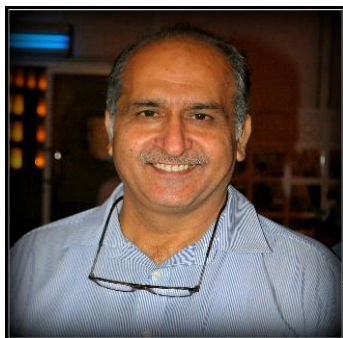

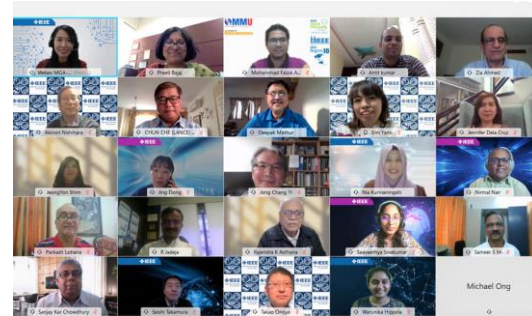
### Description:
