B.3 Professional and Continuing Education Activities

1. Electronic Design Competition: This is an annually organized event of the IEEE Sri Lanka Section. In the competition, undergraduates in Sri Lanka universities design and implement projects to find a solution to a real-life problem using electronics, and other relevant technologies. Each team is composed of 4 undergraduates and one team member must be an IEEE student member. In 2021, 14 teams were registered and 8 teams were selected for the final round which was held on Saturday, Sep 25, 2021, as a virtual event.
2. IEEE Sri Lanka Section 3MT Thesis Competition: This competition is organized for the first time by IEEE Sri Lanka Section in 2021 as an initiation to attract and retain Graduate Student members while giving them an opportunity to showcase their research output to a general audience. In order to participate in the competition, an applicant (1) must be in the second or higher year of an MPhil or a PhD program or have completed the MPhil or PhD degree in a Sri Lankan university/degree awarding institute in the year the competition is held (2) must have an active IEEE membership (e.g., graduate student member, student member, etc.). Total of five applicants, out of all applications received, has been selected for the final round, which was held on Oct 30, 2021, as a virtual event.
3. Webinar on “Take your life back” was held on 13th May 2021, with around 70 participants. It was conducted by Mrs. Rasini Bandara (Psychologists at Mind Heals Pvt Ltd).

Artificial Intelligence (AI) for Massive Internet of Things (mIoT)

Cellular-based networks are expected to offer connectivity for massive Internet of Things (mIoT) systems. However, their Random Access Channel (RACH) procedure suffers from unreliability, due to the collision from the small access massive access. Despite that this collision problem has been treated by existing RACH schemes, these schemes usually require off-line access transmission and re-transmission along with fixed parameters, thus can hardly adapt to time-varying traffic patterns. Without adaptation, the RACH procedure usually suffers from high access delay, high energy consumption or even access unreliability. In this talk, how to optimize the RACH procedure to realize the maximizing a long-term hybrid multi-objective function, which consists of the number of access success devices, the average energy consumption, and the average access delay will be presented.
