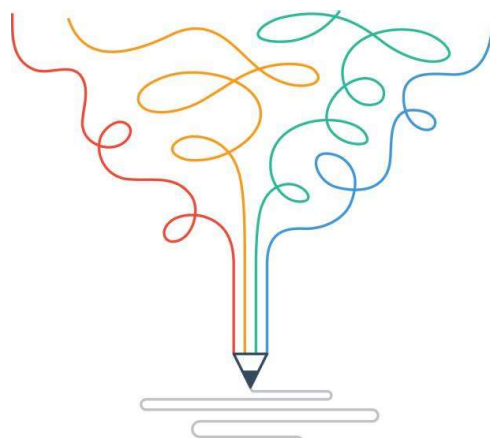

A.1 Executive Summary

B.9 Humanitarian Technology Activities

- On June 2022, heavy rainfall had crippled the north eastern state of Assam leaving lakhs of people scrambling for dry/ high lands, food, and clean water. Assam received 62% above normal rainfall in the pre-monsoon season from March to May this year: 672.1 mm instead of an average of 414.6 mm, the highest in ten years. The rainfall also caused severe landslides in many of the hills surrounding the state. Silchar, the second largest city of Assam faced its worst flood in living memory with more than 80% of the city being inundated. The rainwater from neighboring hilly states like Manipur and Mizoram added to the flooding, breaching the Bethukandi dyke on Barak River was primarily responsible for Silchar's fate. IEEE ComSoc Kolkata Chapter has donated generously funds to help the flood-hit areas of Silchar. IEEE ComSoc Kolkata Chapter in association with NITS-ComSoc Student Branch Chapter took an initiative to visit the flood affected areas and provide relief materials to the flood affected population. The “Flood Relief Activity” was organized on 1st July, 2022. Students and faculty members from the Institution organized this drive to supply cooked food and drinking water to flood-hit areas in and around the institute premises.
- A project titled "**Development of IoT Based Virtual Laboratory System (#22-APHAC-02)**" in response to the IEEE AP-S & IEEE HAC Call for Proposals on Signal Processing Technologies for Local Community Challenges is being carried out the SIGHT Group of IEEE Kolkata Section.
