C3. Collaboration with other IEEE Sections

The year 2022 was a challenging one for the IEEE Sri Lanka Section having the priority to resume all possible events as in-person ones in the post-pandemic era and making sure the execution of the events amidst the financial crisis of the country. As a Section, we believe that we have made significant progress in achieving this, and going forward one of the key action items of the Section is to collaborate and organize multiple activities with neighbouring Sections. Further, we have explored the possibility of organizing an event with a Section from a different region in 2022 and we are confident of putting it into execution in 2023.

C.4 Support extended to Sub-sections & Society Chapters within the Section

• Starting in 2022; we have appointed a Chapter/Sub-section coordinator within the Section Excom to make sure that we provide the required support to all the organizational units. In 2022, we were able to conduct 2 meetings with the chapters and have made significant progress in aligning the activities of the chapters with the annual plans of the section. As a result, as shared in B.2 in detail, chapters have organized multiple technical, educational, and professional activities throughout the year. This also opened up the opportunity to access different funding opportunities available from the global chapters. Two such examples are securing the IEEE CS TechX and IEEE CS Diversity & Inclusion fundings from IEEE Computer Society. One of the key highlights of this effort is the resumption of activities of IEEE Computer Society Sri Lanka Chapter after almost a decade and the same chapter going to become the best chapter for 2022 in IEEE Sri Lanka Section Awards Night.

- Initiate continuous communication with the membership. This year we introduced a News bulletin, which will communicate from time to time (bi-monthly at present) to the membership of the activities conducted by section.
- Having a very active digital presence both as Section and as ExCo members. This would improve the digital presence of the section. Each ExCo member can communicate and share information about the section and its activities through their social media and other physical activities. This elevated the presence of the IEEE Sri Lanka section.
- Create and initiate partnership government organizations. This again will improve the visibility of IEEE in society
- Finally always recognize and appreciate the member community. Especially recognize the past contributors of IEEE Sri Lanka (or your own section)
