On July 13, 1976, the IEEE Bombay Section was founded from the former India Section, together with the sections of Delhi and Bangalore. The current Bombay Section area encompasses Maharashtra, Goa, Daman & Diu. The IEEE Gujarat Section, IEEE Pune Section, and IEEE MP Section sprang out of the IEEE Bombay Section. IEEE Bombay Section is a registered trust with an office at the Don Bosco Institute of Technology in Kurla (W), Mumbai. The Bombay Section is one of the largest sections in India, with 7000+ members, 4200 of which are student members scattered among 100 student clubs across the section's area. There are 14 societies and 4 affinity groups in this area. In 1977, the Bombay Section organized the first workshop to introduce the microprocessor and its applications to our country. The SMC Society's International Conference on Systems, Man, and Cybernetics was held in Bombay in 1984, and it was the first IEEE conference conducted in India. In 1989, the Bombay Section sponsored TENCON, the main annual international technical conference of IEEE Region 10, as well as numerous other notable conferences and other events.
