## Details of Project 3

### Stepping Stones (new) for R10 - seek out and support worthy R10 candidates

Stepping Stone on the path to Milestone (This is based on an existing R5 Award)

Brief R10 AGM attendees at the R10 AGM Ho Chi Minh City  
Call for candidates immediately after the R10 AGM

The Stepping Stone Award recognizes technological innovation and excellence for the benefit of humanity found in unique products, services, seminal papers, and patents.

e.g. invented, initially demonstrated, first used, produced in Region 10, but not yet eligible for Milestone.

Stepping Stone Awards honour the achievement, rather than necessarily a place or a person. Stepping Stones may be proposed by any Region 10 IEEE member.

#### SPONSORSHIP BY R10

Sponsorship has three aspects:

- 1) payment for the cost of the plaque(s);
- 2) arranging the award/presentation event; and
- 3) agreeing to monitor the plaque, informing the Region 10 History Chair if the plaque is in need of repair, needs to be moved, is no longer secure, etc.

Nominal costs of plaque is US \$1000 per plaque
