Developing Web based information tool for higher study: based on the qualification (resume) and TOEFL/IELTS/GRE scores of the student. Arranging student competition in IEEE conferences as in ICASSP to boost up student membership as well as to ensure student participation in those conferences. Arranging student competition on IEEE New initiatives: for gathering brainstorming, ideas about possible funding applications to apply to IEEE NIPs making online education for disabled students accessible and affordable.

C.6 Problems anticipated and suggestions for solutions, if any

Membership Development due to global recession and job loss was a huge challenge. So, running membership drive was challenging.

Also, another problem that we regularly face and which occurred at a higher rate is the unavailability of International Credit Cards. Bangladesh has a strict foreign transaction regulation. Which makes it difficult for someone to get access to International Transaction Enabled Credit Card. Also, the amount in a single transaction is limited. All of these made getting membership in COVID 19 pandemic even more difficult.

Another problem we faced is that due to COVID 19 pandemic, our economy took a hit, especially for Young Professionals and WIE Professionals. So reduced fees for different IEEE Products for YP and WIE Members will help us in this situation.
