

Technology is driving the world's economic growth

- ► The information technology market has a compound annual growth rate of 11.6%¹.
- ► There is an expectation of **65**% of global GDP to be digitalized by 2022².
- ► The World Bank estimates that in the past decade the digital economy has been growing at two and a half times faster than physical world GDP³.

- ► IEEE research powers patents and IEEE creates world's technical standards




- ► IEEE fosters efforts in future directions, technical roadmaps and tracking megatrends

- Increasing our outreach to younger members
- Increase our engagement with industry

Retaining our Younger Members

- From 2015 through 2021, the average of IEEE members in the US increased from 51.8 years to 55.2 years
- Over the same period, the overall IEEE membership average age remained at about 44-45 years due to the influx of student members, mostly outside of the US
- Annual renewal of student members who are eligible to become Higher Grade members from 2016 through 2021 was about 30-33%.
- ► IEEE Young Professional annual retention rates from 2016 through 2022 were between 54-58%







Retaining our Younger Members cont.

- How can we retain our younger members and thus keep IEEE relevant and vital?
- ► I believe that an important element in this is creating a sense of community among IEEE members
- ▶ At the local section level, we need to create a sense of community
 - Talk to your local student branches about IEEE, show that it is more than a student club, it can be a lifelong valuable professional network
 - Go to them, don't expect that they will come to you
 - IEEE can help you with presentation materials, but also talk about how IEEE has benefited you with your career
 - Consider creating job fairs for your student branches
 - Consider creating mentorship opportunities between your local
 YP members and members of your student branches
- ► Also engage your YP members, the best way to keep members is to get them involved, or at least offer ways to get involved
- √ ► Many members would like to help, they are just waiting to be invited








Declining Industry Presence

Strengthening our Value to Industry and IEEE Members Working in Industry

- ► This will require work at the local section level as well as by various IEEE Organizational Units
- ▶ If possible, get members from industry involved in your local section leadership
- Work with your local companies regarding speakers for chapter meetings
- Participate in local trade shows (exhibits, talks)
- Recognize local companies for their activities, particularly those that benefit members
- ► In IEEE organizational units:
 - Create Industry Advisory Boards and solicit ideas about new and current activities that engage industry and people working in industry
 - Participate in industry trade shows as well as larger forums and committees addressing activities of interest to industry
 - Lead the way in important developments, standards, roadmaps, etc. that will help drive the future of industry







Informing the Broader Public about IEEE



- ▶ Did you know:
 - IEEE publications are cited 3x more than any other publisher in the top 50 patenting organizations worldwide
 - IEEE members have won 21 Nobel Prizes so far
 - IEEE members filed over 143,000 patents last year
 - IEEE has over 1,300 active standards with more on the way that standardize the internet, the metaverse, blockchain, etc.
 - IEEE publishes 3 out of the top 5 publications on AI, Automation and Control Systems, and Computer Science HW and SW
- We need to participate in opportunities to talk to non-IEEE groups about IEEE
 - IEEE can provide slides for local efforts to talk about IEEE
 - I want us to talk about IEEE at the WEF, the UN, CES, and other major corporate leader, policy makers, and industry trade shows
 - I want to support the creation of "IEEE is my Competitive Edge" 2.0 videos for international use IEEE should do press releases for significant developments




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Average Age of IEEE Members: Worldwide and US
