A.1.2 Council Highlights

Strategic Growth and Membership Development

- IEEE India Council strengthened its role in coordinating activities across **14 Sections and 14 Sub-Sections**, fostering collaboration, resource optimization, and knowledge-sharing.
- Membership witnessed a remarkable growth, reaching 92,594 members as of 19 December 2024, compared to 86,654 in 2023, marking a 6.8% increase.
- IEEE Madras, Bangalore, and Kerala Sections achieved global recognition, ranking #1, #2, and #4, respectively, in IEEE membership strength.
- A new IEEE Section (Bhubaneswar Section) was formed, further expanding IEEE's reach and engagement in India.
- Senior Member Elevation efforts were impactful, with significant elevations in 2024, strengthening IEEE's leadership pipeline in India.

IEEE India Council Leadership Milestones:



• Dr. Sameer S. M. was elected IEEE Region 10 Director-Elect, a major milestone, elevating India's representation in IEEE's Asia-Pacific leadership.

Flagship Conferences: Driving Research and Innovation

- INDICON 2024, IEEE India Council's premier conference, was hosted at IIT Kharagpur from 19–21 December 2024, organized by Kharagpur Section attracted top researchers, professionals, and students from across the globe.
- INDISCON 2024, hosted by Chandigarh Subsection from 22–24 August 2024, saw an overwhelming response with over 2000 paper submissions and a 20% acceptance rate. More than 400 delegates from India and abroad participated, benefiting from technical paper presentations, expert keynotes, and industry-academia panel discussions. IEEE India Council provided funding support for conference organization and travel grants, enhancing accessibility for early-career researchers.
- TENSYMP 2024, IEEE Region 10's flagship symposium, was successfully organized in Delhi from 27–29 September 2024, fostering multidisciplinary discussions and industry collaborations.

Empowering Students, Young Professionals, and Women in Engineering

- AISYWLC 2024, the flagship congress for WIE, Students, Life Members, and Young Professionals, was hosted by IEEE Madras Section on Dec 7th and 8th, 2024, at College of Engineering, Guindy, Anna University, Chennai created a dynamic platform for networking, mentorship, and professional growth.
- ILS WIE Summits in Delhi and Madras facilitated empowerment initiatives, leadership training, and technical discussions for women engineers.
- IEEE India Council Student Coordination Team celebrated its 10th anniversary on 16 April 2024, with IC Core Team leaders sharing insights on student engagement and leadership growth.

Strengthening Industry-Academia Collaboration

- **IEEE Industry Day and Industry Round Table Discussion**, featuring Dr. Lance Fung (Region 10 Director), Dr. Bernard Lim (Chair, IEEE R10 ACIERT), and Dr. Porkumaran (Madras Section Chair), led to strategic discussions on bridging the gap between industry and academia.
- IEEE India Council Industry-Academia-Young Professionals Committee (IAYPC) was formed in 2024, comprising members from industry and academia, acting as a central hub for skill development, innovation, and economic growth.
- A structured mentorship program was initiated by Dr. John Jose, Industry Relations
 Chair, engaging 5 core team members and 13 industry mentors, impacting thousands
 of IEEE members.
- IAYPC organized multiple industry-focused hackathons, including a Standards Workshop and Hackathon at Sardar Patel Institute of Technology on 19 September 2024, and a Cybersecurity Hackathon in collaboration with India Internet Foundation on 21 September 2024.



• An Affordable Medical Device Hackathon, held on 3–4 October 2024, encouraged innovative healthcare solutions, attracting interdisciplinary teams of engineers and healthcare professionals.

- IEEE Higher Education Summit organised by IEEE India head office in the presence of IEEE President in Delhi where IC Chair Elect Prof Prerna Gaur was a panelist. Hackathons, MoUs, and Collaborations

STEM Kits for Climate Change & Disasters:

10 STEM kits were developed for MOVE India, demonstrated on March 5, 2024, at the GIEEE office, Bangalore. These kits enable hands-on learning about climate change, greenhouse gases, weather patterns, and disaster awareness.

- May 2: Mini MOVE India Truck layout finalized.
